**amorodo**

It is a "wild strawberry or strawberry". From Latin morum, i ("Moorish fruit").

**fiuncho**

It is the "fennel" plant (Foeniculum vulgare).

**lesbiana**

Patronymic female on the island of Lesbos. The meaning for gay woman also appears on this island that was ( it is, but today is called Mytilini ) in the Aegean Sea. There lived in the 6th century a. (C). the poetess Sappho of Lesbos that only accepted disciples ( ) dedicated to those who lit love poems. That school gave origin to the name, although it is not known if Sappho was gay or just a romantic misandra.

**mailo**

It's a contraction of 'mais' and 'lo'.

**morangueira**

Fragaria or morango plant ("strawberry, strawberry") as the Fragaria vesca.

**morongueiro**

It is a variant of the name of the morangueiro plant (Fragaria vesca), and is also a common name for the plant Arbutus unedo.

**xixonés**

It means "Gijón", native of Gijón (city and parish in the Principality of Asturias, Spain).
