The word CARCAVUEZO, already the mentions FRANCISCO DE QUEVEDO, in EL BUSCÓN and that is collected in the dictionary LEXICOGRAPHICAL of CARLOS FERNÁNDEZ GÓMEZ (DOUBLE AWARD SPECIAL OF THE ROYAL ACADEMY OF LANGUAGE) (DIED IN 1981,) (CONSIDERED ONE OF THE FATHERS OF MODERN LEXICOGRAPHY. IN 40 MATIENZO;41 CANTABRIA; THE CALL "34 CARCAGUEZO; AND DESIGNATE THIS PLACE IN IT DISAPPEAR WHERE THE WATERS OF THE RIVER OF 40 MATIENZO; IMPROPERLY CALLED CLARIN BY AN ERROR IN THE NAME OF THE RIVER, IN A ROAD BRIDGE AND BAPTIZED BY 41 PUBLIC WORKS;. THE ROYAL ACADEMY OF THE LANGUAGE, THIS WORD APPOINTS "TO A PLACE OR HOLE THROUGH WHERE 34 WATERS; IT DISAPPEAR. IF ANY DOUBT, QUEVEDO SANTANDER, FROM A NEARBY VILLAGE WAS TO SANTILLANA DEL MAR, MUST VISIT THIS PLACE, SO IT IS CONSIDERED THIS WORD AS THE FIRST OUTLINE OF A PHENOMENON KARST IN SPANISH. FRENCH LE CALLED "PONOR " WHILE IN SPAIN DO NOT SEEM TO ACCEPT THIS TERM.
