Skull (from the Greek ° a±½¯ do ½ kranion and latin cranium)? It is a bone that protects from shock and mainly contains the brain. The human skull is formed by the articulation of 8 huesos1, forming a cavity open and ovoid of variable thickness, with an approximate capacity of 1,450 ml (adults)
